Francis M. Delage junior, born in 1806 in the famous Champagne region, found his passion in Bordeaux wines. In the year 1821, he created and named his first wine Lestissac, in honour of his forefathers originally from the small village Estissac in the Aube Department.

Already at the age of 16, Francis decided to move to Bordeaux to discover the spirit of this winegrowing region. The first moments in this new region were quite difficult as he did not own any vineyard. Fortunately, a cellar master, friend of the family found him a small vineyard in Bordeaux, and some equipment. The cellar master introduced him into the art of viniculture.

The first wine he created was a single 225 l barrel of Lestissac. It was an assemblage created from the grapes of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, the three famous grape varieties of Bordeaux. After the fermentation process he put the wine into an oak barrel for 9 months to release all aromas. He also designed all the labels. Already this first production wine was sold out after some weeks. Thanks to his unique talent combined with his passion for the Bordeaux terroir and the nature, everything what he took into his own hand was a great success.

One year later he inherited a Chateau near the town Bordeaux from his great-grandfather Francois Delage and started cultivating vines in a professional way. That was the beginning of a fast moving success story. Through word-of-mouth recommendation, the story of the young man with the extraordinary talent for making wines was diffused very quickly in the region. Delage was really ambitious and his passion was to create a delicious, exceptional and impressing wine range.

His power, passion and loves were transferred into his wines. The success in Bordeaux wasn't enough for him and so he travelled around to present his wines in bordering regions. Travelling in these times was difficult and dangerous. The young man used a carriage, drawn by a horse, to reach different parts of the land. Finally this idea was crowned with success as he met an investor who helped him to increase his ownership by buying him a wine cellar. He then became more successful, increasing the size of his vineyards and his wine production grew to meet demand.



APPELLATION D'ORIGINE PROTÉGÉE

The grapes come from the Bordeaux region vineyards at the heart of the Entre-Deux Mers between the Dordogne and Garonne rivers. The wine is made from a blend of the Bordeaux region's 3 noble grape varieties - Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc - and gives a well-balanced and harmonious product.

Colour: A deep ruby-red colour.

Nose: This claret has a fine and elegant bouquet with fruity and spicy notes.

Palate: The tannins are silky smooth for a lovely long finish on the palate.



ÉLEVÉ EN FÛT DE CHÊNE
APPELLATION D'ORIGINE PROTÉGÉE

The grapes come from the Bordeaux region vineyards at the heart of the Entre-Deux Mers between the Dordogne and Garonne rivers.

Colour: A beautiful garnet red with rusty reflections and a very intense bouquet with wild fruit and spice.

Nose: The notes of vanilla and cinnamon are a typical feature of this cask-matured wine.

Palate: The attack is clear-cut, tannins are smooth and full to give a long, pulpy finish.



CHARDONNAY

INDICATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE PROTÉGÉE

Colour: Slightly golden yellow with faint lights.

Nose: Very expressive with notes of fresh butter, acacia, pineapple, tropical fruit.

Palate: Round and pleasing wine, fine balance, with notes of lemon.

MERLOT

INDICATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE PROTÉGÉE

Colour: Clear, very intense, garnet red to purple.

Nose: Red fruit, blackcurrants, cherries, raspberry jam.

Palate: Wine with velvet tannins and fine long taste.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON

INDICATION GÉOGRAPHIQUE PROTÉGÉE

Colour: Clear, very intense, almost black, garnet red to purple.

Nose: Red fruit, blackcurrants, green peppers, with notes of spices and hay. Typical of this variety.

Palate: Fine tannic body, notes of liquorice, fine and length of taste.
